

2022 Northern Music Department Trip Update

Dear Music Dept Families:

The Orlando, FL Music Department trip to Walt Disney World and Universal & Islands of Adventure has been rescheduled for a second time and approved by the Northern York County Board of School Directors and is now **April 27th-May 1st, 2022**. Our travel agent, Brightspark Travel, has updated information including a parent letter, a rough itinerary, trip insurance info and the payment schedule that is available on the Northern Music Booster [website](#). We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we have had to wait for details of this trip due to the worldly pandemic and know that we have the student's safety as our number one priority in organizing and taking this trip.

We are optimistic that this trip will happen in April 2022. Our plan is to have each ensemble participate in a Disney workshop, have the Marching band perform in a parade, and have time for the students to explore the theme parks and have positive, memorable experiences that will give them shared social development opportunities in authentic settings.

If you have not withdrawn from the trip and are paid in full, please check your login and password on www.brightsparktravel.com to make sure that all personal information is correct and up-to-date. There is a \$41 per person increase in the trip cost due to a decreased number of people attending the trip from the original 2020 trip. This \$41 increase is due by February 2022, and you may pay it at any time before the due date.
