Here's what to expect:




- You will walk A LOT!!!

USETHOSE EARS!

Make sure you are listening when directions are being given... you don't want to miss a meeting time or place! Respect your chaperones. You will be required to check in multiple times per day.



FIND YOUR TRAVEL BUDDY

- STUDENTS SHOULD TRAVEL IN PAIRS OR GROUPS!
- You do not have to stay with your chaperone or roommates, but will need to speak to your chaperone by phone or see them in person throughout your day. Check-In Times will be announced at the morning meeting and via Remind.
- Call your chaperone if you have a problem.



LUGGAGE



- ONE MEDIUM / LARGE SUITCASE
 - Less than 45 pounds, please!
 - This will travel on our equipment truck; drop off at NHS on Monday 4/25
- ONE CARRY-ON for the airplane
 - Please use a regular sized backpack no large or rolling bags.
- ONE CINCH SAC-TYPE GYM BAG
 - Lighter for in the parks! Fold this up into your carry-on so you have it Wednesday when we arrive.

What should I pack??

- Shorts and t-shirts (Remember NHS Dress Code)
- GOOD SNEAKERS you will walk MILES per day!
- Socks, Underwear, Toiletries
- SUNSCREEN!!! Sunglasses, Hat
- Phone, Charger, Portable Power Source
- Purple Trip T-Shirt
- Spending Money
- We will be in parks all day... wear comfy clothes, no need to pack a lot of extras!
- UNIFORM PARTS N Shirt, black socks and Dinkles, Guard uniform accessories



AIRPORTRULES

Stay with a group!

Have ID Ready (Drivers License or School ID)

Empty pockets into plastic bin; place phones and electronic devices in bin and onto belt for metal detector. (You may also have to take off shoes).

Backpacks must go through metal detector

Any liquids should be LESS THAN 3 oz and all in one quart-sized Ziploc Bag. (Hand sanitizer, Sunscreen, deodorant, etc.) This will go through the scanner also.

Once through the scanner wait for a small group of others, including a chaperone, before going to our gate.



MEET OUR TRIP NURSE:



Michelle Singer, MSN, RN, A-GNP is an alumna of NHS and of the very first Disney trip! She has 23 years of nursing experience and will be responsible for all prescription medications while we are traveling.

Mrs. Singer may call you prior to the trip to go over your meds with you, to make sure we have everything you need.

She will be carrying the standard "as needed" medicines with her, per the field trip form: Tylenol, Tums, etc.

If you feel sick at any time throughout the trip, please contact Mrs. Singer so she can help you, or a chaperone can meet you at the closest First Aid Station.

Northern's Medication Policy

All medications <u>must be given to the nurse</u>.

Medications:

All medications (both over the counter and prescription) to be given during the trip will require a written prescription from your physician (in addition to the prescription bottle) and must be brought in the original container with only enough medication for the trip.

Exceptions to this are the medications listed in the Medical Standing Orders, which will be available by the nurse, as needed and as appropriate (Ex-Tylenol, Benadryl, Ibuprofen, Bacitracin, Caladryl, Cough drops, Tums, Topical Skin Anesthetic).

- Water Donations may be dropped off at this time as well.
- We will ask to see your purple Trip T-Shirt in your luggage!!

- Marching Band, meet at the gate in Frontierland, next to Splash Mountain, at 1:05 to go backstage to prepare for the parade!! Parade is at 2:30 PM. PLEASE be hydrated and eat a little something before meeting the group!
- Marching band performs in parade; other trip participants should line up along Main Street to cheer them on. We will pick a meeting place and let you know where and when.

SATURDAY, APRIL 30TH



UNIVERSAL STUDIOS ALL DAY TODAY

Grab breakfast at hotel before leaving.

Spend the Day at Universal Studios, Orlando.

Check out the Hollywood Rip Ride Rocket and the Transformers Ride.

Enter Diagon Alley to experience Harry Potter magic! Escape from Gringott's, shop for a wand, buy a chocolate frog.

YOUR PASS FOR UNIVERSAL IS A PARK-HOPPER PASS. This allows you to ride the Hogwarts Express between parks or to exit Universal Studios and go next door to Islands of Adventure. THIS IS OK, BUT YOU MUST STAY IN A GROUP AND CHECK IN WITH YOUR CHAPERONE AT THE REQUIRED TIME AND PLACE!!!

SUNDAY, MAY 1ST



LAST DAY - Universal

Load luggage on truck. Keep what you need for the day with you.

Breakfast at Hard Rock Café

Head to Universal Islands of Adventure

Check out the Hulk Roller Coaster, the land of Dr. Seuss, and Harry Potter's Hogsmeade village.

YOUR PARK-HOPPER PASS IS VALID AGAIN TODAY. You may ride the Hogwarts Express or walk between parks. You MUST check in with your chaperone at the designated time.

BUS to Airport, FLY to Philadelphia, BUS back to Dillsburg.

YOUMUST BE IN SCHOOL ON MONDAY!!!



CHAPERONE RESPONSIBILITES

- Exchange phone numbers with your students.
- Check in with students throughout day at designated times.
- Assist students at airport check-in / screening.
- Room Checks in the evening; deliver bottled water to your students at this time.
- Daily chaperone meetings for information on the next day's schedule.
- Morning check-ins, make sure students are up / eating breakfast.



HEADING FOR HOME

- Students will travel on two different flights to return home. Your flight and its arrival time will be announced soon.
- Remind messages will be sent to update parents at home with a better idea of our ETA to Dillsburg.
- We will fly home with just the backpack carryons. Equipment truck with luggage should arrive in Dillsburg on Monday afternoon. Stay tuned for more info on when we will unload the truck and distribute luggage. PLEASE DON'T PACK ANYTHING IN YOUR SUITCASE THAT YOU WILL NEED BEFORE TUESDAY!!



HELPFUL HINTS FROM DISNEY TRAVELERS:

There are water filling stations throughout the parks. Save your empty bottles and refill them during the day, or bring your own refillable bottle.

Disney gift cards can be used anywhere on Disney property for food, souvenirs, etc. These are available at Sam's Club (for a slight discount!) and also Target.

There are a few apps that you can download to check ride wait times at the parks, look at maps, etc. "My Disney Experience" is a good one, which you can also use to make reservations at sit-down restaurants.
